
Leave me alone...! Case 2

Here we bring to your attention the case of a 43 years old woman, who was consulted from Prof. Petrela for common head ache four years ago. Neurological examination was normal.

MRI showed a lesion on the left frontal region with" bubble like" characteristics on T2, hyper intense comparing to grey matter, localized on the white subcortical matter, without signal restriction on diffusion.

Radiological data suggest a "Leave me alone" lesion, which was found incidentally, taking into account the clinical history.

Since 2018, the patient is followed up with yearly MRI and clinical evaluation. Three continuous MRI-s show constant sizes of the lesion without pathologic findings in clinical evaluation.



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
