


Fig. 1 axial images of FLAIR sequences







Fig.2 axial images of SWI sequence




Fig. 3 Sagittal T1 -weights images





Fig. 4 Sagittal T2- weights images





Fig. 5 Sagittal T1-weighted images after administration of intravenous contrast
