A brain MRI was realized as shown,




Fig 1a: Brain MRI ,FLAIR sequences




Fig 1b:Brain MRI DWI sequences



Fig 1c: Brain MRI T2W TSE AXIAL sequences




Fig1 d: Axial T1 weighted axial sequence without and with gadolinium
